Training Sessions

We've now run several sessions at Brodick Park, Hollycroft and these sessions have concentrated on the skills necessary to introduce the riders to cycle racing - we think these sessions have been successful and providing we get sufficient attendance we aim to continue these sessions on a fortnightly basis for the foreseeable future, yes even into the winter months!

Racing



We have been invited to take part in the Welland Valley Whizz Kids Go-Racing event on Sunday 22 August at Misterton Park, near Lutterworth—this should be great fun! Format is an off road time trial on tracks followed by a cyclo-cross race, both in age groups. An info sheet is attached and all entries are 'on the day' (no advance entry required). First stage starts at 10.00 am. Suggest you get there at 9.00 am to complete your entry, pay your fee and take a look at the courses.

Membership

Our aim when we started Go-Ride was to improve the membership of Hinckley CRC and at one of the sessions I gave out HCRC 'Flyers' membership forms. Membership for Under 12's is Free and for 12-15 years is a bargain £5. I would encourage you to join the club asap as future sessions may be for members only. Parents can join the senior section of the club to, riding membership costs £15 per year and non-riding (Associate) is a mere £3. Family memberships are also available. Future Plans


